



MISS JUAB COUNTY SCHOLARSHIP PAGEANT Guideline and Regulations/Contract for participation

1-Official entry application must be received online NOT LATER than Tuesday, July 14th at 5pm. 2026 Pageant date is Wednesday, July 29th at 7pm. LATE APPLICATIONS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.

2-Contestant must be a resident of Juab County for SIX months prior to and at the time of the pageant. Must be a legal citizen of the United States of America. Must be biological female.

3-Contestant must be single, never married, never cohabitated and must not be nor, never been pregnant.

4-Contestants must have completed their JUNIOR YEAR of HIGH SCHOOL (11th grade) and not more than 21 years of age.

5-Contestants must be of good moral character, never convicted of any crimes.

6-Categories of competition/judged are the following:

8–10-minute individual interview with judging panel

Present a talent not to exceed 90 seconds.

Model evening wear

Model production number wear (this varies from year to year)

Answer an onstage question.

7-If your talent requires music, video you must submit to Donni Pay 10 days before the First stage rehearsal for the pageant. CONTACT DONNI with questions.

8-Participate in pageant workshops to learn production/opening/introduction number.

Participate in other pageant workshops organized to help contestants with each

Category of competition. Pageant stage rehearsals at the Junior High are required.

ALL rehearsals and workshops are for the pageant contestants only. During the

Pageant each contestant may have ONE backstage helper that is not a family member.

9-Contestants will have a pageant photo shoot for head shots date tba at pageant meeting.

10-Each contestant should be ready to share their community service involvement Through their application and in their judge's interview.

11- Pageant Dates/Deadlines and requirements are given at the Pageant Contestant Meeting held prior.

12- If selected to the MISS JUAB ROYALTY you understand all obligations of the title, Time commitment, duties (attend all Juab County Fair events as scheduled, Parades, Community events, Grand openings, community events as directed by Committee. Being the face of Juab County, you are ambassadors. Proper conduct, modest dress, Best behavior, language and confidence, poised behavior. Be on time and prepared. Participation in activities may present risk of injury, all efforts go to protect the Royalty in the event of accident or injury we will not hold the Miss Juab Committee Or Juab County responsible.

13- If selected to MISS JUAB ROYALTY you will forfeit your title if you marry, become Pregnant, move out of the county (exception is moving for college), are convicted Of a crime or for any other reason cannot or unable to fulfill the duties required of Miss Juab County or behavior is not in line with the duties and responsibilities of Miss Juab County.

14- Be thoughtful and precise in completing your application. All information you provide Will be used for judges to formulate questions in their interview. Please be sure you Complete all sections of the application with your signature and your parents.
