INDIVIDUAL INTERVIEW

with the judging panel — 8–10 minutes
40 POINTS

The judges will formulate questions based on your application information and Juab County facts



MODELING of EVENING WEAR and PRODUCTION WEAR

10 POINTS EACH

(each contestant models evening gown of her choice, production wear, contestants' choice anything sparkly in red, white or blue)



TALENT

30 POINTS

Each contestant will present a 90 second talent of their choice. It will be timed.

ALL RECORDED MUSIC or VIDEO must be turned into **DONNI PAY** by or before **JULY 20th**



ON STAGE QUESTION

10 POINTS

Each contestant will be asked the same question. This question is not to stump you but rather to let your personality shine.



ALL workshops and rehearsals are for contestants **ONLY**.



At the pageant each contestant may have **ONE** backstage helper that is not a family member. We want your families to enjoy watching you shine!

MISS JUAB based on total points
Clothing, gifts, flowers, crown, photo, cash prize



FIRST ATTENDANT based on total points

clothing, gifts, flowers, crown, photo, cash prize
